
Mina Ho - Next Winner in Line



Mina Ho at the Disney Animation Boot Camp in Monterey


Mina Ho, an illustration senior, has won a Disney scholarship. This means that her last year's tuition is paid for and she can look forward to a guaranteed job upon graduation.
